

ORDINANCE NO. 2024- 03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 10.12 OF THE REPUBLIC MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD A NEW SECTION 10.12.025 ENTITLED "PARKING IN ALLEYS RESTRICTED".

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Republic, Washington, has determined that it is necessary to protect the health and safety of the residents of the City of Republic ("City") and the public at large, that certain regulations be enacted to restrict parking to a limited amount of time in City alleys.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Republic, Washington, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1 – AMENDMENT BY ADDITION.

There is hereby added a new Section 10.12.025 to the Republic Municipal Code entitled "Parking in Alleys Restricted" as follows:

10.12.025 Parking in Alleys Restricted. The parking of vehicles in any alley within the City of Republic shall be restricted as follows:

- A. Loading and unloading materials or supplies from vehicles shall be limited to a maximum of forty-five (45) consecutive minutes;
- B. All other parking of vehicles shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) consecutive minutes.

For the purposes of this section, "alley" shall mean a designated alley contained on the original map of the townsite of the City of Republic.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3 – EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the City Council, approval by the Mayor, and five (5) days after publication as required by law.
