A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY AT AN ELECTION TO BE HELD WITHIN THE CITY ON AUGUST 4, 2026 OF A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING A CONTINUING PROPERTY TAX LEVY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$.50 PER \$1,000.00 OF ASSESSED VALUATION FOR EACH YEAR FOR SIX CONSECUTIVE YEARS BEGINNING IN 2027 FOR THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AS PROVIDED IN RCW 84.52.069

- **BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Republic, Washington do ordain as follows:
- Section 1. That the City of Republic shall provide emergency medical care of emergency medical services, including related personnel costs and training of such personnel, equipment, supplies, vehicles and structures needed for the provision of emergency medical care or emergency medical services.
- Section 2. In order to produce the revenue adequate to pay the costs of providing for emergency medical care and services as described in Section 1 of this resolution and to maintain funds sufficient to assure continuation of such emergency medical care and services, the City shall levy in 2026 and collect in 2027 general tax on taxable property within the District for the sum of fifty cents (\$0.50) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) of assessed valuation.
- <u>Section 3.</u> There shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the City, for their ratification or rejection, at an election on August 4, 2026, the question of whether or not such levy shall be made.
- Section 4. The County Auditor is hereby instructed to place on the ballot the following proposition with regard to a special levy for emergency medical services:

EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE AND AMBULANCE SERVICES LEVY

"Will the City of Republic be authorized to impose regular property tax levies of fifty cents (\$.50) per thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) of assessed valuation of property in each year for six (6) consecutive years for the provision of Emergency Medical Care and Services, to be levied for the City in 2026 for collection in 2027 and subsequent years through 2032?"

Section 5. If the proposition passes by the margin and in the manner provided for in RCW 84.52.069, then and in that event only, the City of Republic shall levy the special levy as set out in the ballot.
